WHAT IS UNIVERSITÉ PARIS DAUPHINE - PSL, LONDON CAMPUS?

We are part of Université Paris Dauphine – PSL, a prestigious university in Paris which specialises in economics, management, law, social sciences and mathematics. As a founding member of Université Paris Sciences & Lettres (PSL), we are consistently ranked among the top 50 universities in the world: 40th by the 2022 Shanghai Academic Ranking of World Universities, 19th by 2022-23 Center for World University Rankings and 24th place and best French University in the QS 2024. By joining us, you are signing up for a degree from one of the most prestigious Higher Education Institutions in the world.

WHAT SETS US APART?

Our courses meet the finest standards of Higher Education worldwide. In 2022, we registered with the UK Office for Students (OfS), the independent regulator of Higher Education in England, which means that we meet their requirements for course quality, academic standards, student support, student protection and more. Our faculty team draws from the highest standards of anglophone teaching methods, through the world-class academic experience they received at some of the most elite universities globally.

We also wear our French influence on our sleeve, with rigorous coursework and significant amount of contact hours – indeed, roughly twice the amount of most UK universities. Our Bachelor's leads to the award of the prestigious degree of Grand etablissement from Universite Paris Dauphine – PSL and is EQUIS accredited.

WHAT'S THE CAMPUS LIKE?

Our beautiful, modern campus, with bright and spacious classrooms, breakout areas, a rooftop garden and a yard for socialising, is just a two-minute walk from Angel tube station, or a fifteen-minute walk from King's Cross St Pancras International. We're remarkably close to all the amenities that Central London has to offer.

WHAT ARE THE LANGUAGES REQUIREMENTS?

A proficient English level is required. We put a real emphasis on language proficiency and all of our students must study at least one additional language during their time with us. We want to prepare you for the exciting and international career you deserve, and language proficiency and cross-cultural understanding are essential components of that. At the University College London (UCL) Centre for Languages & International Education, you can choose from 9 languages.

WHAT COURSES DO WE OFFER?

In addition to the Bachelor's in Economics and Management, our boutique institution also delivers Executive Education and Summer School programmes, Study Abroad tracks and houses a Startup Incubator. With about 350 students yearly, we are able to give everyone the individualised attention that they need to succeed in a challenging and ever-changing international business career.

COURSE STRUCTURE: BACHELOR'S IN ECONOMICS AND MANAGEMENT

Our Bachelor's in Economics and Management aims at training students who will operate in complex, cross-cultural, and demanding economic and business environments.

Our aim is to help our students to **become** well-rounded, adaptable, and high standards professionals, with strong analytical, problemsolving and communication skills in several languages. Beyond professionalism, our aim is to educate **responsible citizens**, aware of their responsibilities in society at large and the economic and business world in particular.

The two first years of the course provide a rigorous and theoretical strong foundation to high quality studies in economics, management, quantitative disciplines, law and social sciences. The third year of the course focuses mainly on management, while keeping an interdisciplinary approach.

Most of our students decide to study for a Master's at Université Paris Dauphine - PSL after their Bachelor's degree, in line with the French tradition. However, with Dauphine - PSL degrees among the most highly sought-after in the business world, you can also go straight into work after you graduate.

Thanks to our partnership with UCL, our students can follow optional foreign language classes, use UCL student facilities including libraries, sport grounds and join UCL societies.


DAUPHINE LONDON STUDENT UNION (DLSU), SOCIETIES & CLUBS

JOINING UNIVERSITÉ PARIS DAUPHINE - PSL, LONDON CAMPUS

The Bachelor's in Economics and Management is designed for students with a strong interest in those subjects and in working internationally. We only accept students of the highest calibre, who have the potential to flourish in a supportive but challenging environment.

FOR UK STUDENTS

At the moment, you can't apply to our London campus via UCAS, but you can apply by filling the form available on our website (UK Application Procedure). This means you can apply to our programme in addition to your five UCAS choices.

FOR THE FRENCH BACCALAUREATE

Students preparing the French Baccalaureate (including LFE students) must apply via the Parcoursup platform ('filière sélective') at parcoursup.gouv.fr. The application window is open from 17 January to 14 March 2024.

- English language requirements: **B2 minimum.**
- We only accept English tests from **UKVI** approved providers (IELTS SELT Consortium, LanguageCert, Pearson, PSI Services).
- Please only apply when you have received the results of your English test.

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students must apply through our **UK Application Procedure,** unless they are completing the French Baccalaureate. You will need to fill the form available on our website.

We only give conditional offers and expect students to keep up with the course and the following predicted grades:

- A-Levels: AAA, with an A in Mathematics
- **IB:** 35 points
- Other diploma equivalent: you must have taken Mathemathics in the final two years of school and achieved the equivalent of the grade of 'A' in A-levels in Mathematics.
